ISRP SECRETARY'S ANNUAL REPORT FOR 2005 May 2006

In 2005 the individual membership showed a modest increase over 2004, but the number of corporate members showed a slight decrease.

No of Individual Members = 74, plus 1 Honorary Member

No of Corporate Members = 6

The International Society produced 2 editions of the Journal which were distributed to members.

In line with expectations from last year, almost all of our administrative business was conducted by e-mail. We continue to mail important notices to members, and we try to combine these with mailing the Journal.
